- 7) New Business:
  - a. Kevin Bunn driveway. Kevin Bunn asked for approval of a driveway at 1670
    Vega Ave, Mayer. After discussion, Mark made motion to approve as long as it is over 100 feet apart from other access, seconded by Ron, MSC (3-0-0)
  - Steve driveway Upland Ave. Driveway at 1980 Upland Ave., Mayer. After discussion, Mark made motion to approve, seconded by Bruce F., MSC (3-0-0).

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- c. Road Limit Waiver Warrior Specialty Contractors Bruce F. made motion to approve, seconded by Mark, MSC (3-0-0)
- d. Nick Hartwig Feedlot questions Mr. Hartwig appeared before the board with questions regarding the feedlot requirements. He is supposed to be 200 feet from property line, the barn is only 30 feet currently and wanted that taken into consideration. Mark made motion to approve, seconded by Bruce F., MSC (3-0-0).
- e. Carver County Sheriff Department Commander Mike Wallin Commander Wallin spoke to the board about questions they had regarding police calls such as noise complaints, animal calls, etc... He explained that Base Level Calls such as domestic, burglary, bodily harm, etc. are what all taxpayers pay for. Contract level calls are the animal and public nuisance type complaints. Community Service Officers are used for low level instances but only used for entities that contract with the Sheriff's Office. He suggested that if the township was interested in contracting with the Sheriff's Office they could contact other cities or townships within the county that does contract with the Sheriff's Office and see about sharing some type of position. After much discussion, Commander Wallin said he will get back to the board with anything he comes up with. Mark mentioned about talking to Mayer.

- g. 42<sup>nd</sup> St. Culvert the township was notified by the county regarding a culvert on 42<sup>nd</sup> St. The township was not aware of this and did not budget for it so we do not have the funding for it. Mark will contact the county about it.
- h. Dust Control Dust Control has been challenging this year. Pam has spent quite a bit of time on it. Next year she would like to just send notices to residents who have done it before.

Batteries in Mack keep draining – he will wait until fall to purchase new one.
